You, your guardian, or a support person applies for one of our vacant SDA properties

Hume will support you through the application process. All the steps are made clear and available to you in a method most suitable to your needs

2

Information gathering process

Hume will work with you and your support people, to gather information about your accommodation needs, and status. Needs could mean what we need to do to keep you safe in your home. Status includes SDA and NDIS funding.

3

Meeting potential Housemates

Hume will hold a meeting between you, your guardian, the potential SIL provider and your housemates to see if they are the right fit for you.

4

Decision making process

After reviewing your application, needs, status, and introducing you to your housemates, Hume will decide on whether to approve your application. The answer may be a yes or no. Either way, Hume will let you know in writing of the outcome.

5

Welcome to Hume

If says yes to your application, this means you are approved to move into your new SDA home. Hume will work closely with you and your support people to make sure you understand your rights and responsibilities of living with Hume, including the agreements we both must sign.

6

Transition planning.

Hume works with you and your support provider (SIL) on a transition plan that meets your needs. You are included in this plan to make sure you have everything you need for your home and support.
